## TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

### Travel Documents

Remember to carry your passport and travel documents in your hand luggage – not in your suitcase. It is also a good idea to keep photocopies of these documents in a separate bag while travelling and leave a copy at home with family or friends in case of emergency.

### Passports

Passports are required for all countries included in our program. Ensure the expiry date is valid for at least six months beyond your intended departure from Europe. Your passport may be required at border crossings or when you check into hotels. It will always be required when you cash traveller's cheques.

### Visas

Please note that a visa is required for entering Egypt, Romania and Russia. Currently citizens of Australia, New Zealand, United States of America, Canada and the United Kingdom do not require visas for travel to any of the other countries visited in our itineraries.

As conditions may change, it is your responsibility to check with relevant Embassies or Consulates as well as your Travel Agent to ensure that all necessary visas are obtained prior to your departure.

### Insurance

We highly recommend that you obtain comprehensive Medical and Travel Insurance to cover your time away from home. You should check these items are adequately covered:

- Medical costs and Personal Accident
- Loss or damage to baggage
- Loss of traveller's cheques and credit cards (fraudulent misuse of stolen traveller's cheques or credit cards)
- Cancellation and curtailment fees.

Bring a copy of your insurance policy with you so you can follow correct procedures should you need to file a claim.

### Don't Forget To...

- Cancel all deliveries to your home.
- Arrange for someone to clear your mailbox.
- Let your neighbours know you'll be away.
- Unplug electrical items and turn off your hot water.
- Check locks and put valuable items in a safe or bank.
